Configure Grid Options

When looking at pages in Platinum Planner, you will frequently see a little gear button near the search fields. This button is a very handy, often overlooked tool, **Configure Grid Options**. When you click on it, you will see a dropdown that contains two options, **Add/Remove Columns** and **Reset Grid To Defaults**.

When selecting the former, the **Column Chooser** will appear, and this window will allow you to modify the columns that are displayed in your grid. It will contain additional fields that can be dragged and dropped into your table. The selections that you see will vary depending on the

page that you're looking at. For example, if you are viewing your **Manage Students** page, you would have a field for **Time Zone ID** so if your students are reporting that times seem off in their accounts you can check to see if anyone has made an improper selection.

In this week's "Know The Rules!," I am diving into the second standard of Physical Safeguards of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA).



Physical security is an important component of the HIPAA Security Rule that is often overlooked. What constitutes appropriate physical security controls will depend on each organization and its risk analysis and risk management process.

A workstation is defined in the Rule as:

"An electronic computing device, for example, a laptop or desktop computer, or any other device (including mobile) that performs similar functions, and electronic media stored in its immediate environment."

Q: What is secure testing? How should I implement/troubleshoot secure testing?

A: There are a lot of options for our test settings in EMSTesting. One of which is the ability to enable secure testing. It is important to know what is involved and its limitations before enabling this for your students.

When secure testing is enabled it has the students install a secure testing browser. When installed, when a student clicks begin test, it then opens the test in secure testing browser. When secure testing is open it does not let the students navigate to other sites or applications. This is a great way to lessen cheating or look up answers.
