Ask the Customer Support Team

Q: How does "Sign Up By Start Date" and "Sign Up By End Date" work when I am setting up my students opportunities? A: The "Sign Up By End Date" lets you set the minimum number of days in advance a student can sign up for an opportunity. Entering the number "7" would mean that students can sign up for an opportunity no less than 7 days before it is scheduled. Entering a negative number, like "-20", means that students have to sign up for this opportunity no later than the 20th of the previous month. Entering a specific date, such as "12/15/2018", means that students must sign up for this opportunity by that specific date.
