Keeping It Real – Scenario Hacks

Don't have thousands of dollars to invest in high fidelity simulators? Here are 10 hacks to make scenarios more real.

- 1. Use a medical student or nurses to serve as model patient.
- 2. Use male patients to allow for uncompromised makeup application and encourages true exposure of chest injuries for trauma scenarios.
- 3. Don't forget the cold cream!
- 4. Ask ahead of time about allergies.
- 5. Use nontraditional clothing on the patients and bystanders to set a mood.
- 6. Make cheap blood for the mouth. 2 cups powder sugar, 1 tsp vanilla, 1 fluid oz. Red food coloring, 1 cup of Karo syrup. Thin as needed with warm water.

- 10. Don't forget the odors, sound effects and lighting.

Q: In EMSTesting and PlatinumTests, can my students see their questions, rationale, and the correct answers on their Computer Adaptive Tests? A: There actually is not a way for students to see the correct answer and rationale on the Computer Adaptive Testing when they finish a test. There are two reasons we don't allow them to. The first is that the CAT draws from the same question bank as the linear test generator does. If they could review their CAT questions and answers, students would know the answers to questions you could present to them in class without having to actually study.
