A: To better serve the SMC23 vision of the pediatric age group skills, we've slightly changed the way the formative version of these skills are accessed. For Paramedic SMC23 courses we've added new skill group skill totals in addition to the overall pediatric patients (formative) and Pediatric patients (competency) group totals. Courses that did not change from our base original template should see

Why study EMS at Inver Hills?


